Executive Summary

In order to support the NHS ambition to reach net zero by 2040, NHS England asked all Integrated Care Systems (ICSs) to develop and submit a first system Green Plan by 31 March 2022. The Plan which was submitted covered eight national areas of focus (* five regional priorities 2022/23)

- 1. Workforce and system leadership
- 2. Sustainable models of care
- 3. Digital transformation*
- 4. Travel and transport*
- 5. Estates and facilities*
- 6. Medicines*
- Supply chain and procurement*
- 8. Food and nutrition

The initial phase has been completed with the submission of our first ICS Green Plan, which mainly focused on the NHS Trust Green Plans. The plan also explores operational initiatives and potentials for scaling and adoption across the system. Since submission we have started our engagement with colleagues across the ICS in particular learning from local authorities, Healthwatch and primary care with a view that we need a wider collaboration on this important theme. The plan will be published on the ICB website.

The next phase will be to ensure the ICS collectively embeds the green lenses and places sustainability at the heart of the decision-making processes, across all ICS functions and activities.
