## **Executive Summary**

The Board Assurance Framework (BAF) sets out the principal risks to the achievement of the ICB's strategic objectives and is a practical means through which the Board can assess controls against delivery of these. In doing so, the BAF is also a primary source of evidence in describing how the ICB is discharging its responsibilities for internal control.

The BAF further sets out the controls in place to manage these risks and the assurances available to support judgements as to whether the controls are having the desired impact. It additionally describes the actions to further reduce each risk.

This report presents the BAF (Annex 1) and the red rated risks (Annex 2) on the Corporate Risk Register (CRR) for consideration and discussion. Members' attention is drawn to the following:

- All risks, including risks scores, positive assurances, gaps in control and mitigating actions have been updated, as appropriate, with the Executive Director Leads since May reporting, and taken through the Executive Committee and Audit and Risk Committee for assurance before being submitted to ICB Board.
- All risks have been assessed against system priorities and meeting the Integrated Care System (ICS) four key aims.
  - Improving outcomes in population health and health care.
  - o Tackling inequalities in outcomes, experience, and access.
  - Enhancing productivity and value for money.
  - Helping the NHS to support broader social and economic development.

The BAF is also indicative of where it sits currently in terms of its maturity within a new ICB. Directorates are currently focused on ensuring the risks escalated to the CRR reflect the current operating environment, this is still in development.

The report also provides an update on the progress made in development of a comprehensive risk management process, ensuring a joined-up approach is adopted, to enact appropriate management and oversight of risk, both locally and across the wider collaborative.
