Date of BOBFPC Recommendation	February 2024

Treatment for Dupuytren's Contracture will be funded in line with the NHS England (2018; updated 2019) Evidence Based Interventions Statutory Guidance:

An intervention (needle fasciotomy, fasciectomy and dermofasciectomy) will be considered for:

• Finger contractures causing loss of finger extension of 30° or more at the metacarpophalangeal joint or 20° at the proximal interphalangeal joint.

OR

• Severe thumb contractures which interfere with function

Radiation therapy for early Dupuytren's disease is not normally funded due to lack of high-quality evidence of clinical effectiveness.

NOTES:

- Potentially exceptional circumstances may be considered by a patient's ICB where there is evidence of significant health status impairment (e.g. inability to perform activities of daily living) and there is evidence that the intervention sought would improve the individual's health status.
- This policy was developed and recommended by Thames Valley Priorities Committee which was the predecessor of Buckinghamshire, Oxfordshire, and Berkshire West ICB and Frimley ICB Priorities Committee.
- This policy will be reviewed in the light of new evidence or new national guidance, e.g., from NICE.
